NSIV received a research infrastructure grant of \$3.1 million from the Massachusetts Life Sciences Center. The grant will allow NSIV to refurbish and expand its current laboratory facilities over the next three years and purchase advanced analytical instrumentation. **Gloucester Marine Genomics Institute** (GMGI) was awarded the \$500,000 Senator Kenneth J. **Donnelly Workforce Success Grant**. GMGI plans to use the grant money to provide training and placement services for 80 unemployed/underemployed young adult students to become future lab technicians, lab technologists or
